QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGIONAL REPRESENTATIVES

1. Candidates for Regional representative must be at least fifteen (15) years of age and no older than eighteen (18) years of age on the date of election and be an active member of a Y.O.U. chapter.
5. Candidate is an experienced leader, demonstrating self-discipline, cooperation, responsibility and consideration for others. Candidate has demonstrated the ability and commitment to carry out the roles and responsibilities of the desired office.
6. Candidate has a good understanding of basic Unity principles and applies them in his/her life. Each Regional Officer continues their personal study of Truth Principles by reading Unity books recommended for the 'Leaders of Vision Award'.

REGIONAL REPRESENTATIVE RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Regional Representatives serve as inspirational Spiritual leaders and role models of Unity truth principles, facilitate communication and contact among regional chapters, preside over business meetings, work with the Regional Consultant to plan regional retreats, rallies and leadership trainings and implement service and other projects for the support and development of YOU, including the promotion and support of sub-regional activities and events.
2. As regional Spiritual Leaders, Regional Representatives agree to role model Unity Truth principles in all of their words and actions including all online communications, using only appropriate, respectful language and refraining from the use of all profanity, put downs to any person or group or any other offensive or inappropriate language that would reflect negatively on Unity Worldwide Ministries, the region or regional YOU
3. A regional Representative may not hold International office during his/her term as Regional Representative.
4. Regional Representatives must be willing to spend time developing the skills needed for effective leadership as follows.
 - a. A commitment to prayer, meditation, and continued personal spiritual study while in office.
 - b. Understanding beliefs basic to Unity for answering questions and teaching others.
 - c. The ability, through practice, to lead prayers and meditations in public.
 - d. Ability to communicate with people of all ages in an effective loving manner, and speak to large and small groups, as well as individuals. This includes developing listening skills in addition to verbal clarity and effectiveness.
 - e. Willingness to step back when appropriate to let others use their talents and abilities for the benefit of all.
 - f. Facilitation skills for participatory workshops and activities they will be leading. This includes: giving clear directions, involving everyone, group movement, discussion skills.

- g. Willingness to thoroughly research and prepare workshop material and learn how to present an effective workshop.
 - h. Understanding the Regional Representatives are part of a team and must develop a team player consciousness- no one individual is more or less important than the whole.
5. Regional Representatives understand that their purpose at Regional events is leading and facilitating, and the purpose supersedes time for personal fun, spending time with their chapter or entering into optional activities.
6. Regional Representatives uphold all Heart Agreements and assist adult leaders in maintaining the integrity of agreements within the group.
7. Regional Representatives attend all Regional YOU events and the International YOU Conference.
8. Other Responsibilities and duties include:
- a. Prepare a letter of introduction to the Region for the Regional Web site.
 - b. Research, select and promote a regional service project. Service project is promoted at Fall Rally and via facebook, newsletter and web site.
 - c. Develop a Truth Talk or workshop for presentation at Region rallies.
 - d. Promote YOU within the region and support the development of new YOU chapters and the growth of existing chapters using all appropriate technologies. (Facebook postings, calls, etc.)
 - e. Participate in Spiritual development practices as required by Regional Consultant.
 - f. Prepare inspirational facebook posts.
 - g. Plan regional rallies and retreats with Regional Consultant. Be available for a Fall and Spring planning weekend as well as team phone conferences scheduled by Consultant throughout the year.
 - h. Be on time for meetings and phone calls and fully prepared to participate with all pre-meeting assignments and actions complete.
 - i. Put aside all personal will and desires to make every recommendation and decision from the highest point of spiritual awareness for the very best for the entire region. Speak and act positively and constructively focusing on the desired outcome.
 - j. Bring a sense of humility, honesty, trust and integrity to all interactions and service on behalf of the region.
 - k. Maintain regular attendance and active participation in their local chapter's activities.

Officers must be driven to all events by an adult (25 years or older). Any exceptions must be approved by the regional consultant

RALLY PLANNING WEEKENDS (2)

Requirements:

One before Fall Rally (Sometime in August at my home in Roanoke, VA) and one before Spring Rally (Sometime in January, location to be determined.) Planning begins Friday eve at 6pm and ends on Sunday around Noon.

Expenses:

Expenses are paid by YOUer, Parent or Church. (Exception: Friday dinner; breakfast, lunch, snacks on Saturday and Sunday Breakfast at my home is my treat. YOUer should be prepared to pay for dinner out on Saturday night - a modestly priced restaurant will be selected.)

FALL AND SPRING RALLY:

Requirements:

Regional Team goes to Camp Tockwagh on Thursday before Rally. Adults accompanying officer can also spend Thursday night at Camp and their help with set up for Rally is appreciated

Expenses:

Travel and Travel Food: paid for by YOUer, Parent or Church. Breakfast, lunch and dinner at Tockwogh on Friday for leaders and accompanying adults is paid by the Region.

Officer Registration: 1/2 is paid for by the Eastern Region. Parents attending Rally register with chapter and pay full registration fee.

LEADERSHIP TRAINING:

Requirements:

One Leadership Training before Spring Rally (March) in location to be designated. Travel on Friday, depart Sunday at Noon.

Expenses:

Travel and Travel Food: paid for by YOUer, Parent or Church.

Registration: Paid by Eastern Region

INTERNATIONAL Y. O. U. SUMMER EVENT:

Note: Regional Representatives are encouraged to register and attend the International YOU Summer Event if one is scheduled.

Expenses: Current Eastern Region policy is to pay \$400.00 for each regional representative to attend International Summer event. This covers the \$400.00 early registration expense. YOUer, Parent, Church pays any costs/fees not covered by Region. Regional Policy for 2014 is subject to change by the UWMER Board.
