#### INFORMATION ABOUT RALLY

#### WHO MAY ATTEND?

Eastern region YOUers, sponsors, ministers, parents and chaperones are all invited to join in a weekend of fellowship, fun, and spiritual growth. YOUers must be in grades 9,10,11 or 12 or equivalent, with a minimum age of 14 and a maximum age of 19; or, if not in high school, a maximum age of 18. Teens must be accompanied to Rally by a ministry-approved adult 25 years or older of the same gender as the teen(s). Any exceptions (including YOU graduates) must be approved by Kate Adamson, Head Sponsor of Unity of Charlottesville before registration deadline.

All Adults attending must submit a copy of a national background screen within last 3 years with their registration if it has not been previously provided.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- Check-in will be from 5:00 to 6:00 PM Friday. Please arrive during that time period so that your chapter will not miss the important 6:00 meetings (and dinner!) and opening activities at 7:00pm.
- All people registering for the Rally are committing to be in attendance for the ENTIRE WEEKEND, arriving at the camp on Friday afternoon and staying through the closing on Sunday.
- Rally will end at about noon on Sunday, and will include a take away lunch.

Specifically, this means no inappropriate sexual content, put-downs to any group, gender, or individual, even in the name of "humor". ### First-Timer Buddies / Logistics Team Members Qualifications and Responsibilities

#### Logistics Team and Buddy Qualifications:

- Has attended at least 1 prior Rally and active member of Chapter
- Has shown integrity keeping the Heart Agreement and an understanding of Unity Principles
- Buddy: An open heart and sufficient social skill/maturity to carry out Buddy Responsibilities.
- Logistics Team: Has maturity/ and physical capability to fulfill Logistic Team Responsibilities
- Recommended by Sponsor to serve as a First-Timer Buddy or Logistics Team Member

#### **Buddy Responsibilities**

#### First-Timer Meeting:

A meeting of First-Timers and Buddies will be held at 6:00pm on the Friday of Rally. Arrive on time to attend the meeting. Come to the meeting ready to welcome first-timers and show enthusiasm. There will be get-acquainted activities for Buddies and First-Timers.

#### **During Rally:**

- 1. Help your first-timer in any way you can with the registration and settling in process.
- 2. During Rally, introduce your first-timer to your friends and invite first timers to join you in meals and activities.
- 3. When you see your first-timer during rally, ask how their experience with Rally is going What they've enjoyed or struggled with. Share your Rally experience with them.
- 4. If you see your first-timer sitting or standing alone or looking lost or awkward, go up to them and talk to them. Invite them to join you and your friends.
- 5. Be to your First-Timer the type of friend you would have appreciated having during your first Rally.

#### **Logistics Team Responsibilities**

#### **Logistics Team Meeting**

Check In with Adult Logistic Team Leader when you arrive at Rally. Attend any scheduled Team meetings at the beginning of Rally.

#### **During Rally**

The logistics team is available to assist the Charlottesville Chapter and adult logistics leader with any and all logistics including room break down & set up (setting up/taking down tables and moving chairs) room cleanup, distributing supplies whenever needed.

LT members may be asked to assist with Talent show set up/ Cleanup and/or Snack setup and cleanup.

At mealtimes, LT Members serve as Role Models by cheerfully assisting with cleanup and encouraging all YOUers to do their share.

#### Qualifications

- Has attended at least 2 Rallies
- Is at least 15 years of age at time of Rally
- Sufficiently articulate to fulfill Family Group Leader Responsibilities
- Has attended past leadership Trainings (Recommended but not required)
- Has demonstrated maturity and understanding of Unity Principles
- Has demonstrated Leadership Qualities in home chapter and/or church

#### Responsibilities

#### Prior to Rally

Spend time in daily meditation and/or prayer practice prior to coming to Rally Review all family group materials carefully and thoroughly prior to coming to rally. Participate in pre-Rally phone conference if requested by YOU Consultant

#### **During Rally**

Attend 6:30 Family Group Leader meeting
Be a positive role model for Family Group and entire Rally body
Live and express Unity principles in all words and actions
Be prepared and on time for each Family Group meeting
Listen with an open heart and mind to any feedback from Adult Sponsors in Family Group



#### RALLY PREPARATION MEETING

**Sponsors:** Prior to coming to Rally, please hold a meeting with all YOUers and adults attending rally to review the items below. During the meeting, lead a group discussion on the following topics.

#### 1. Heart Agreements

Scenarios and discussion questions are attached as a separate document. One of the most important discussions to the Rally consciousness we are trying to create is the discussion about heart agreements. Thank you sponsors for giving attention to this topic.

#### 2. Intentions and Goals for Rally

What specific goals and intentions does each YOUer and adult participant have for Rally? (Typical goals might be feeling closer to God, making friends, renewing friendships, taking more time to pray, learning to speak up in a group, sharing a special talent or ability, or learning to appreciate or get along better with others.

#### 3. Individual Contributions to Rally?

What will you do before and during rally to make this a good experience for yourself and others?

#### 4. Expectations

All YOUers and Adults\* must attend **ALL** activities and stay with the group at all times. Everyone must arrive on Friday and not leave until Closing on Sunday. Help your group feel a part of the total experience. Arrive during check in 5:00-6:00pm in time to get settled in before the 6:00pm meetings (and dinner!) and the opening celebration at 7:00 pm on Friday evening. Adults in the group are responsible for the YOUers they bring to Rally. Please be aware of medical needs and medications, be vigilant and check in with YOUers regularly during the event. \*Adults may be excused from large group activities to obtain needed rest.

#### 5. Share Information about rally

- a. Family Groups: Each YOUer and adult will meet 4 times during the weekend with their assigned small group.
- b. Fuzzies: This is the time when everyone exchanges friendly hugs.
- c. Spirit Share / Talent Show: This is the opportunity for Rally participants to share their talents with everyone. The Spirit of the Talent Show will be one of Spirituality, cooperation and appropriateness. Rehearsal for the show will be held during the beginning of free time on Saturday afternoon.
- d. Adult Support Team: Several adults, both male and female, are designated as "Head Sponsors". Their job is to support the other Sponsors and assist the Regional Team in maintaining harmony and order throughout the Rally weekend.
- **6. Prayers and Affirmations**: Lead your chapter in prayer, sending love and blessings to the regional team and all rally participants affirming perfect unity, harmony and order for the entire weekend!!



#### HEART AGREEMENT DISCUSSION

**Sponsors:** The scenarios below were provided for the first time prior to Fall Rally 2014 and may have been previously discussed by your YOUers. Please revisit them anyway. Feel free to provide other scenarios and invite your YOUers to suggest other situations that could arise during an event.

#### **General Questions**

- 1. Why do we have Group Agreements at Unity events? What is the purpose of having Agreements?
- 2. What is the difference between a rule and an agreement?
- 3. What is the difference between breaking a rule and failing to keep an agreement?
- 4. What is the difference between keeping an agreement and following a rule?
- 5. What is the value of keeping our word? What is the nature of integrity?
- 6. In what ways can breaking the heart agreements at Rally affect us, our fellow YOUers, our sponsors, the regional YOU program?
- 7. If a YOUer is sent home during Rally, how does that affect others?

#### Scenarios

- 1. A group of YOUers are talking and giggling together near you during the Godwalk. You are upset by this as you have looked forward to the silence and the talking is disturbing to you.
- 2. You learn that a group of YOUers plans to meet to smoke pot after hours on Saturday night.
- 3. Your boyfriend / girlfriend wants you to sneak out to meet him/her after hours?
- 4. You learn that your friend is planning to meet her boyfriend/ his girlfriend to slip away from the crowd for some alone time during free time. They are planning to go out of the boundaries to be alone.
- 5. The third chime has sounded at vespers and adult leaders have asked that everyone go to bed. You continue to say goodnight and give and receive hugs to your friends ignoring the request.

#### For each scenario

- 1. What are possible actions that might be taken in response to the situation?
- 2. What are possible actions that would support upholding the heart agreements?
- 3. Of the possible actions that might be taken, what actions violate the Heart Agreement?
- 4. What specific Agreement would be violated?
- 5. Why do we have this specific agreement included in our Agreements?
- 6. How do honesty and accountability play a part in the choices you make?
- 7. Who would your actions affect, or potentially affect if you choose to break the heart agreements?
