**Reverend Cherie Ruffo is** the co-founder and Minister at Unity Radiant Light in Rhode Island. She is also a freelance writer, teacher, and entrepreneur. She is author of the middle-grade fantasy book series: *Amanda Fisher & the Source Crystals*, loosely based on the 12 Powers.

She is the co-founder and Managing Member of Chrysalis Environmental Services, LLC since 2006. She worked for the Epilepsy Foundation of Hawaii and Washington, and the Diabetes Foundation of Rhode Island. During her tenure at these organizations, she founded three kid's camps that are still in operation today.

She is currently enrolled in the Boston University Professional Fundraising Program Certification Program to refresh and broaden her fundraising skills. In September of 2022, she will become a Certified Professional Fundraising Executive (CRFE).
